Patient Information

Your patch test results indicate that you have a contact allergy to naphthol-AS. This contact allergy may cause your skin to react when it is exposed to this substance although it may take several days for the symptoms to appear. Typical symptoms include redness, swelling, itching, and fluid-filled blisters.

Where is naphthol-AS found?

Naphthol-AS is used in textile coloring and also in scientific applications as a fluorescent dye probe and stain. It is also found in antioxidants, fungicides, insecticides, deodorizing agents, and as an Azo dye coupling component.

How can you avoid contact with naphthol-AS?
