## **Patient Information**

Your patch test result indicates that you have a contact allergy to hexachlorophene. This contact allergy may cause your skin to react when it is exposed to this substance although it may take several days for the symptoms to appear. Typical symptoms include redness, swelling, itching, and fluid-filled blisters.

## Where is hexachlorophene found?

Hexachlorophene is used as a topical anti-infective, anti-bacterial agent in medicines. It is also found in soaps, toothpastes, and in the agricultural industry as a soil fungicide, plant bactericide, and acaricide.

## How can you avoid contact with hexachlorophene?

Avoid products that list any of the following names in the ingredients:
