Your patch test result indicates that you have a contact allergy to musk ambrette. This contact allergy may cause your skin to react when it is exposed to this substance although it may take several days for the symptoms to appear. Typical symptoms include redness, swelling, itching, and fluid-filled blisters.

Where is musk ambrette found?

Musk ambrette is found in products that are sensitive to light. It is an ingredient in colognes and after shaves.

How can you avoid contact with musk ambrette?

Avoid products that list any of the following names in the ingredients:
