Acetophenone azine is found in ethyl vinyl acetate foam, which is used in the padding of sporting equipment and footwear.

How can you avoid contact with this allergen?

Avoid products that list any of the following names in the ingredients:

- (E)-1-phenyl-N-[(E)-1-phenylethylideneamino]ethanimine (IUPAC)
- Acetophenone azine
- Ethanone, 1-phenyl-, azine
- Ethanone, 1-phenyl-, 2-(1-phenylethylidene)hydrazone
- SR-01000631677-1

What are some products that may contain this allergen?

Acetophenone Azine is a chemical commonly found in the foam padding of sports shoes and equipment such as tennis shoes, ski boots, shin guards, insoles, swim goggles, and bicycle seats.
