Isobornyl Acrylate is a chemical commonly used in adhesives, sealants, agricultural products (non-pesticidal), ink-, toner-, and colorant products, paints and coatings, plastic- and rubber products.

How can you avoid contact with this allergen?

Avoid products that list any of the following names in the ingredients:

- Acrylic acid isobornyl ester
- IBA
- IBOA
- IBXA
- 2-propenoic acid

What are some products that may contain this allergen?

Artificial nails, adhesives, dental composite fillings, dentures, gel nail polishes, hearing aids, personal hygiene pads, printing inks, rubber coatings, and UV cured glues and glucose monitoring systems and insulin pumps.
